This is to inform that Zydus Healthcare Limited ("ZHL"), a wholly owned subsidiary of the Company has received an intimation under section 143(1) of the Income Tax Act, 1961 ("IT Act"), determining demand of Rs. 284.58 crores, while processing the Return of Income of ZHL.

ZHL is also going to file Rectification Application under section 154 of the IT Act, before the CPC as well as before the Jurisdictional Assessing Officer against the said intimation. Once the rectification order is passed, the entire demand will be deleted.
